- To develop their understanding of the world, where different continents, countries and seas are located and where the counties within the UK are located
- To understand and identify the differences between human and physical geography
- To develop their confidence of using practical field work skills
- high quality and ambitious teaching where we build children's knowledge, skills and concepts sequentially so learning opportunities reflect the needs of all pupils
